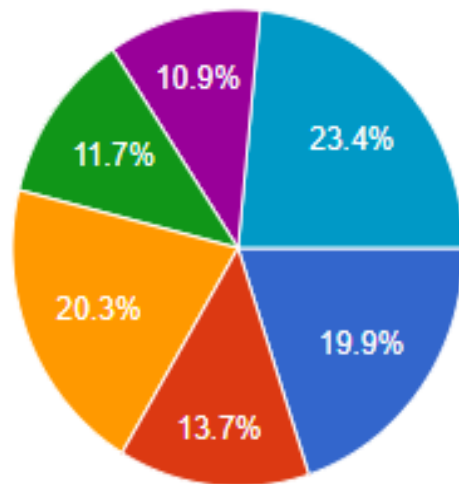

What year is your daughter in?

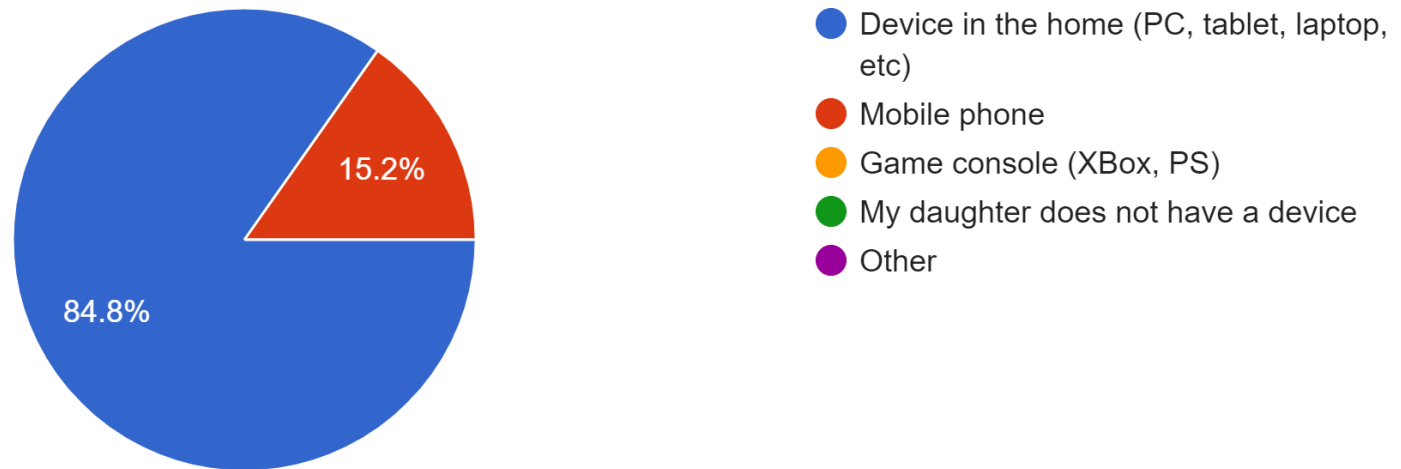

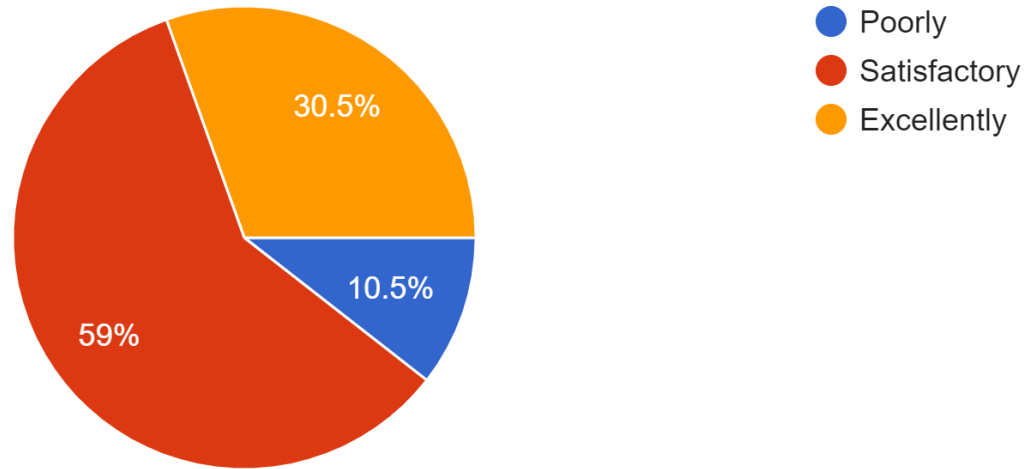
What is the main device your child is using to access her online classes/assignments?

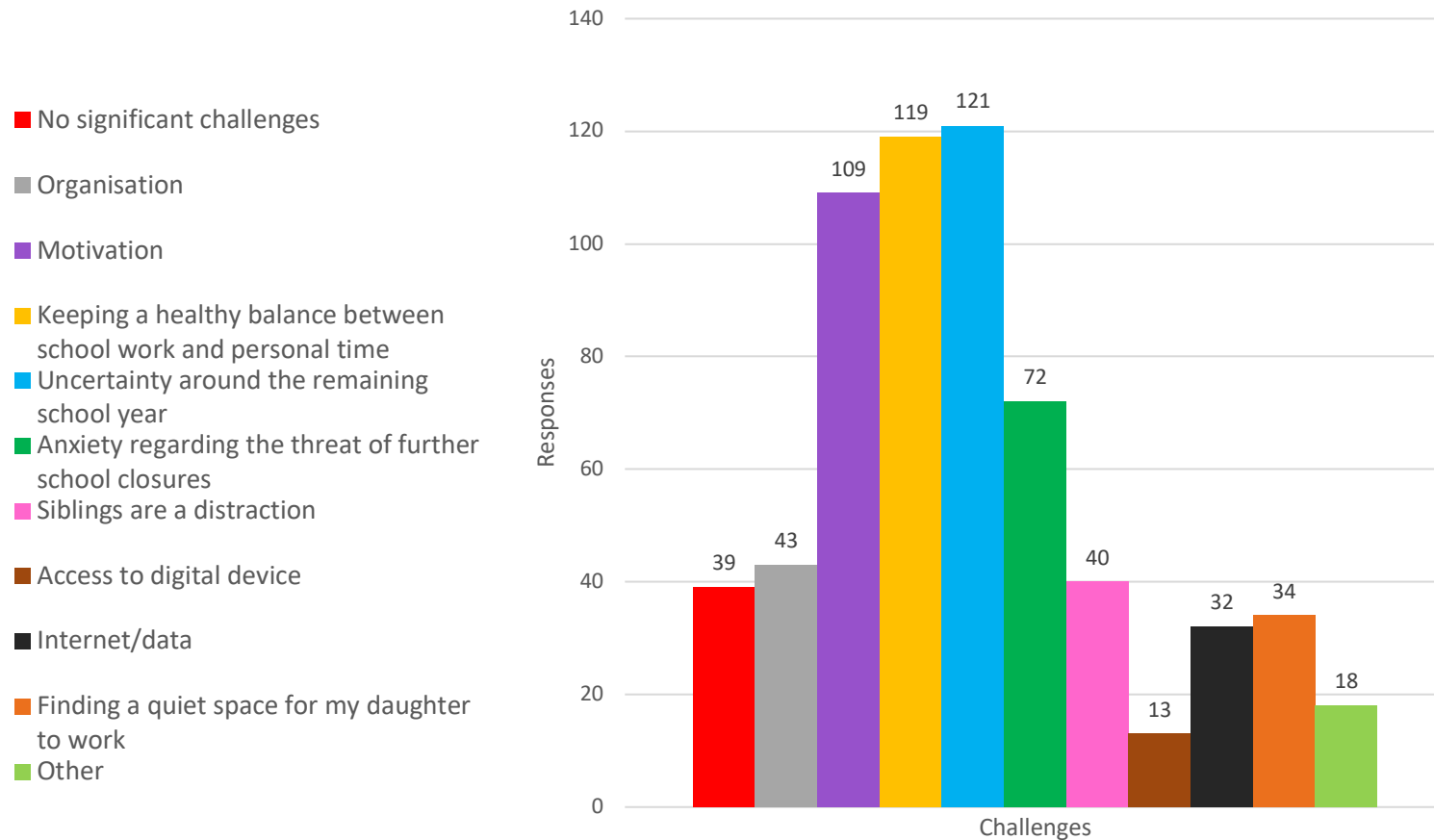


How well has your daughter adjusted to learning in the home setting via remote teaching?

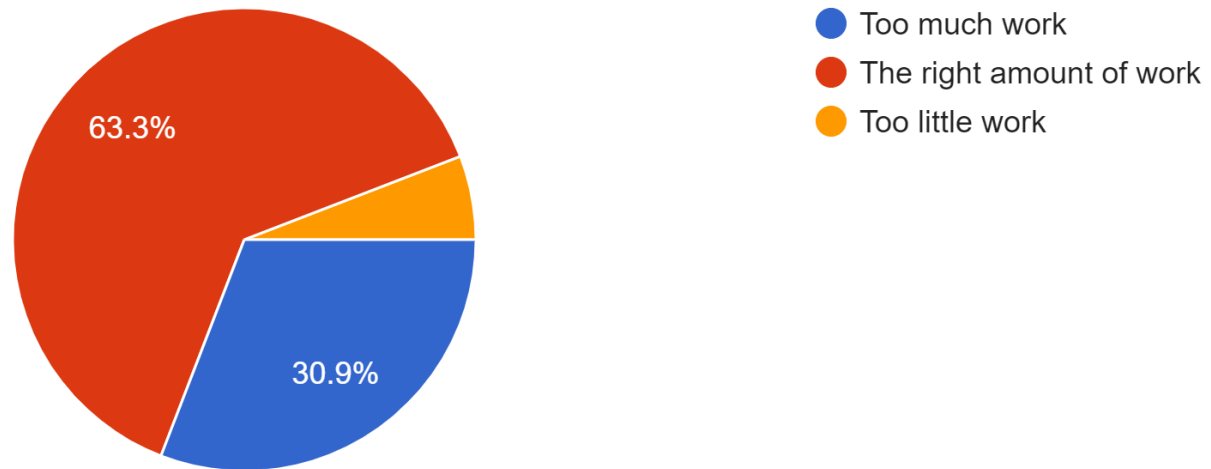


What challenges has remote teaching and learning presented for your child?



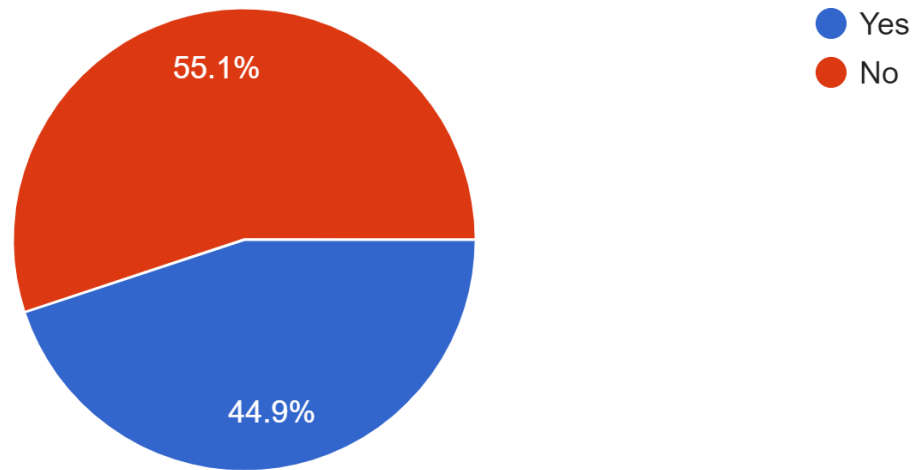
Regarding the amount of work your daughter is receiving from her teachers - do you feel that she is receiving

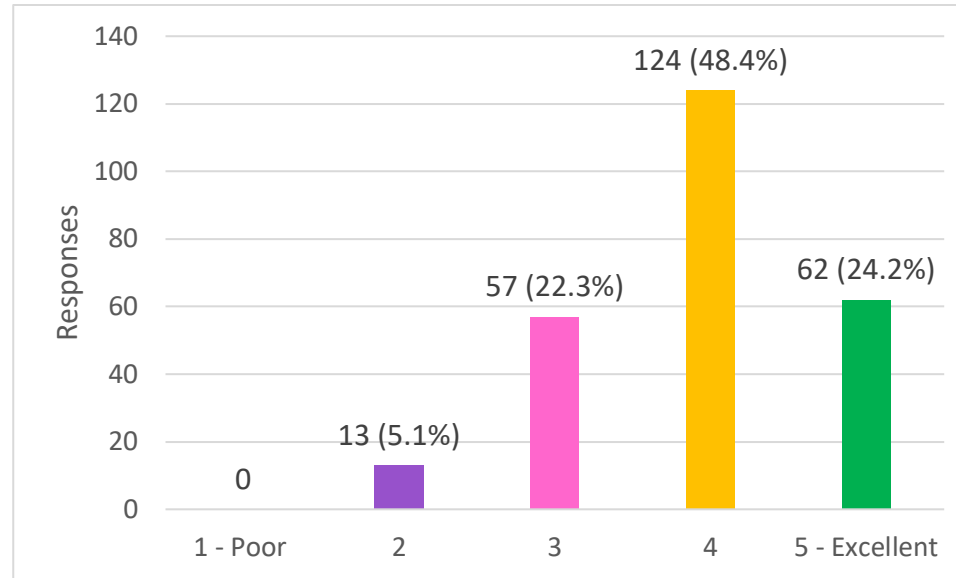


Have you any concerns regarding online teaching and learning for your daughter?
